MSDS or also known as Material Safety Data Sheet training is also included in the course. Even if not related directly to the use of a lift truck, MSDS training is essential in the event that an operator notices a leaking container or damages a container containing toxic materials. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and correct methods of handling spills.
