Introduction

General Hazards

The most common workplace dangers consist of falls, slips and trips. Accidents similar to these take place as a result of the employee losing their balance and stumbling over something which has not been correctly put away. Placing or removing things from storage could lead to a fumble or slip, potentially causing both worker and item to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when staff are moving supplies on various types of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common danger is getting hit by falling stuff. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting methods are another common danger.

Warehouse machines carries inherent hazards. Accidents or injuries could be caused by forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks if they are not operated correctly. Warehouse tools, such as skids, pallets, strapping and cutting tools, must be used carefully throughout packing, unpacking and loading.

Materials that are dangerous, combustible or flammable present another type of workplace danger while being stored in a warehouse. Workers should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers when working around dangerous materials.
