Loader Training Langley - Loader Training Programs - Be Safe All the time - Any person who wants to operate a lift truck has to take a Loader Training course to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are different ways to acquire forklift training. Courses are provided through workforce training agencies, company forklift certification programs, and approved on line and video courses. The price can be minimal (or free of charge) when offered through employment agencies or by occupational safety officers on job sites.

Forklift operators must be 18 years of age or over, in nearly all countries. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training programs and require operators to acquire a certificate before utilizing this type of heavy machinery. A certificate is valid for four years in nearly all areas. Companies that hire staff to drive forklift trucks could face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators can lead to serious injuries and property damage because of improper use of the equipment. Training includes the right driving and loading techniques. Workers must pass a written exam to be able to be certified. A company would normally designate a supervisor to be able to provide hands-on training to new workers. A certified supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be licensed as a trainer.
